Dana Horn and Todd Gross gave the water, sewer & streets report. Their well came and pulled well 2 and replaced all galvanized pipe with plastic pipe, Parkston electric came and rewired the bad wire. We put in the rebuilt pump & motor. The line painting in business district should be done in June. Waiting to hear back about putting in new fire hydrants. We exercised hydrants and found 3 more that need replaced. The Chip seal on North Main and South Main the oil is leaking through, will be fixed the second week of July, we will keep sanding until then. In July SDARWS will be here to start pot holing 97 random selected water pipes on the city side to see what material of the line (lead or non lead), the project will be cover under a grant only cost to the city is filling in the hole & providing our manpower. Parkston Electric has ordered the electric parts that need replacing at the pool & will begin that process in August. Will be getting a quote for the sofit/wafer board for the city hall office building. Booster pump for well 1 &2 needs looked at, we have a spare on hand need to inspect the couplers and gaskets, will get a quote to repair. Check and Gate Valve need replaced at the lift station will be getting a quote for repair on that as well.

Motion by Cody Fischer and seconded by Glen Batterman to approve the bid from Mid Continental to Tuck point & paint the city office for \$16508. Motion Carried.

Police Chief Corrinna Wagner gave a copy of the police report. Highway safety grant will be audited on Thursday.

Motion by Randy Squier and seconded by Marcillio Mora to approve a permit for the Dugout to sell alcohol on the sidewalk in front of their building July 2nd-6th. Motion Carried.

Motion by Randy Squier and seconded by Glen Batterman to approve a building permit for Seth Washman to build a roof over the porch. Motion Carried.

Motion by Randy Squier and seconded by Mark Mora to approve a building permit for Larry Miller to build a privacy fence and put in a flagpole. Motion Carried.

Motion by Glen Batterman and seconded by Mark Mora to approve the city office to approve building permits unless it is questionable or if it needs a variance. Motion Carried.

Motion by Mark Mora and seconded by Marcillio Mora to approve and sign our contract with District III. Motion Carried.

Motion by Randy Squier and seconded by Glen Batterman to approve the election results for ward II (10-Andrew Ravelo & 28-Cody Fischer). Motion Carried.

Motion by Glen Batterman and seconded by Cody Fischer to adjourn with the old council at 8:33pm. Motion Carried.
